ARTICLE V
DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 2. Vice President for Programs

The Vice President for Programs shall act in the place of the president, in his/her absence or disability, and preside at a designated session during the annual conference. The vice president for programs shall be chairperson of the Program Committee whose responsibility shall be to develop and coordinate programs to aid in achieving the goals and objectives of NAC.

ARTICLE VIII
DUTIES OF STANDING COMMITTEES

Section 4. Program Committee

The Program Committee shall be chaired by the vice president for programs and shall develop and coordinate programs in achieving the goals and objectives of NAC.

ARTICLE VI
DUTIES OF STANDING COMMITTEES

Section 3. Program Committee

The Program Committee shall be chaired by the vice president of programs of the NAC. It shall be the responsibility of the program committee to service, disseminate and assist with the execution of programs to service the needs of advancement staff and alumni volunteers of historically Black colleges and universities to achieve the mission and goals of the NAC and the UNCF. The target audience for programming shall be institutional advancement staff to include fundraising officers, alumni affairs directors, publications and public relations directors, and planned giving officers; alumni association officers, student affairs staff, and campus organization officers in addition to IAC, NAAs and other organizations.

The Program Committee shall coordinate its work with the Membership Committee to insure the availability of a comprehensive range of services to constituent members.
